Impressionism and Photography. The invention of photography had several different lineages. The first permanent photograph was made in 1826 by Joseph Niepce, but photography became more widespread in 1839 after Louis Daguerre (France, 1787-1851) invented the metal-based daguerreotype and William Henry Fox Talbot (England, 1800-1877) invented the paper and salt print process involving the negative/positive approach that came to be associated with film photography.
